1. Dial **0203 481 5237** or **0203 481 5240**
2. When prompted, enter the **Meeting ID: 890 1146 1733**, followed by #
3. When asked if you have a **User ID**, just enter #
4. Enter the **Passcode: 618243**, followed by #
5. If you can, **turn your phone to MUTE once the service begins** – this avoids interference.

If you have a copy of 'Rejoice and Sing' we will try to provide the hymn numbers so that those on the phone can access the words.


